## **NICK VATAKIS, MD**

Nick Vatakis, MD, is board certified in Psychiatry and is the Medical Director of SPRI Clinical Trials. Since joining SPRI in 1997, Dr. Vatakis has served as Principal Investigator on over 200 clinical trials in the areas of Depression, Anxiety, Schizophrenia, Alzheimer's Disease, MCI, Bipolar Disorder, Sleep Disorders, Migraine, Stuttering, Smoking Cessation, Post-Herpetic Neuralgia, Fibromyalgia, Addiction Disorders and Sexual Dysfunction. He obtained his medical degree from New York University and did his residency at NYU Medical Center. Additionally, Dr. Vatakis maintains a private practice and serves as a CNS consultant to several sponsors and CROs.

## **EVGENY FINK, MD**

Since joining SPRI in 2010, Evgeny Fink, MD, has trained under Dr. Vatakis as a Sub-Investigator and has served as either the Principal Investigator or Sub-Investigator on over 25 clinical trials, across many therapeutic indications. Dr. Fink earned his medical degree from Smolensk State Medical Academy in Russia and did his residency training at both Smolensk State Medical Academy and Beth Israel Medical Center of New York, where he is on staff. Additionally, Dr. Fink maintains a private psychiatric practice. He is the co-author of several publications on Schizophrenia, Affective Disorders and Opiate Dependence.

## **FACILITY**

The Social Psychiatry Research Institute (SPRI) is a dedicated research facility located in the heart of Brooklyn, NY, one of the five boroughs of New York City. The total population of NYC is over 8 million and Brooklyn accounts for 2.5 of this total, with as much ethnic diversity as Manhattan.

Located less than one mile from the ER of Coney Island Hospital, a full service medical center, SPRI's facility is equipped with double-locked, limited access medication storage, and a CLIA-waived processing laboratory with refrigerated, -20 and -70 degree sample storage. SPRI performs on-site ECGs and infusions and maintains relationships with local facilities that perform PET, MRI, CSF sampling, PSG and other special procedures that may be needed in a clinical trial. The clinic is easily accessible from all five boroughs using public transportation; however most of its research participants live in Brooklyn. SPRI maintains a large database developed over many years of running trials in NYC and also recruits through community outreach, referrals from area practices and advertising.
